Market Review: During the month of March 2020 KSE-100 (the benchmark) posted a massive decline of 23.04% on account of outbreak of contagious coronavirus. Downfall in global oil prices due to weakening demand for the fossil fuel on account of coronavirus also led to panic in market.

During the month Auto Parts & Accessories, Cement, Glass & Ceramics, Chemical, Engineering, Fertilizer, Pharmaceuticals, Technology & Communication, and Power Generation & Distribution sectors performed better than other sectors while on flipside Oil & Gas Exploration, Banking, Oil & Gas Marketing Companies (OMCs), Paper & Board, Auto Assemblers, and Textile Composite sectors remained the underperformer. Foreign investors remained net seller with the outflow of US\$ 84.70 million during the month under review, as compared to outflow of US\$ 56.40 million in previous month.

Fund Commentary: During the month under review, First Capital Mutual Fund's NAV has decreased by 23.06% as compared to decrease of 23.04% in KSE-100 (the benchmark).
