Stock Market Review: During the month of March 2018 KSE-100 (the benchmark) increased by 5.37%, mainly attributed to the expectations for currency depreciation and consequent firming up of interest rate hike. Furthermore, expectations for some tax relief for the capital market and listed sectors in the upcoming federal budget also support the market.

During the month Cement, Chemical, Commercial Banks, Fertilizer, and Oil & Gas Exploration sectors outperformed the market, while on the flipside Automobile Assemblers, Engineering, Oil & Gas Marketing Companies, Textile Composite, Pharmaceuticals, and Technology & Communication sectors lagged the market. Foreign investors remained net-seller with the outflow of US\$22.392 million during the month under review, as compared to outflow of US\$32.053 million in previous month.

Fund Commentary: During the month under review, First Capital Mutual Fund's NAV has increased by 3.77% as compared to increase of 5.37% in KSE-100 (the benchmark), thereby underperforming the benchmark by 1.59%. The Fund underperformed the benchmark mainly on the back of low weight in Commercial Banks, Power Generation & Distribution, Cement sectors and zero weight in Chemical sector stocks which outperformed the market.
