**Market Review:** During the month of July 2022 KSE-100 (the benchmark) decreased by 3.35% to close the month at 40,150 points. Decrease in benchmark mainly attributed to political instability after the success of PTI in the Punjab bi-elections. Disbursement of the IMF tranche which was reflected in USD/PKR deprecating during the month also caused to loss investor's confidence in stock market. During the month under review Commercial Banks, Food & Personal Care, Glass & Ceramics, Oil & Gas Exploration, Oil & Gas Marketing, and Technology & Communication sector stocks performed better than Market while on Auto Assemblers and Parts & Access., Cable & Elec. Goods, Cements, Engineering, Fertilizers, Pharmaceuticals, Refinery sector stocks remained the underperformers.

Foreign investors remained net buyer with the inflow of US\$ 7.48 million during the month under review, as compared to outflow of US\$ 8.82 million in previous month.
